	The 5 C's of repentance:	
	0	Conviction: Godly sorrow begins with a deep conviction of our sin, as the Holy Spirit touches our hearts and shows us where we've fallen short.
	0	Contrition: This conviction leads to true contrition—a genuine sorrow for having grieved God, not just regret over getting caught or facing consequences.
	0	Change: Out of contrition springs change, as repentance turns us away from sin to Christ and compels us to pursue a new direction in Him.
	0	Clearing: Godly sorrow produces a clearing of ourselves, when because of Godproduced change within and forgiveness received, we seek to be right with God and others (if possible), restoring relationships and walking in integrity.
	0	Commitment: Finally, godly sorrow cultivates a renewed commitment—a zealous desire to honor God, live righteously, and continue growing in faith.
